Additional Notes:

Packaging:

- Please ensure boxes and equipment are wrapped in garbage bags. Supers should have tape around the box to hold the frames securely in place. A band of tape around each end of the box, near the ears, is effective.
- Please ensure packaged equipment is tidy and self-contained.
 - o No live bee or wasp hives or other animal infestations (e.g. mice);
 - o No badly rotting materials;
- Please package equipment securely such that incidental bees, moths or other insects don't escape packaging. This will also prevent other debris from escaping the packaging.

Handling:

- Pallet Guide:
 - If stacking tall pallets of boxes (e.g. 9 boxes high), please place a pallet about half way up the stack, in order to allow us to split one tall pallet into two short pallets, making handling easier and safer for staff and equipment;
 - Please keep the box weight to 40lbs or less, wherever possible;
 - Please use pallets that are in good condition, in order to avoid unsafe stacking and product damage;
 - Please wrap pallets securely.

- Smaller quantity orders or, smaller quantities of assorted equipment:
 - Wherever possible, please stack equipment on pallets and wrap securely in order to ensure the fastest loading and unload of your vehicle;
 - If bringing loose equipment, not on pallets, we can provide a pallet on which you can unload your equipment.
 - As a note, please keep in mind that our process is geared towards the quick removal of material using forklifts or pallet jacks – we are happy to assist with hand unloading/loading, if possible, but our Staff are normally scheduled for internal activities and may not be available to assist.

Communication:

- Group communication:
 - Please communicate with Iotron through the Group Organizer;
 - Please bring a completed copy of this form with the equipment and indicate your name/Group directly on your materials;
 - Please bring equipment to Iotron only during the pre-arranged drop-off/pick-up times.

- Individual orders:
 - Min. order fee of \$500 applies to orders processed outside of a Group or on a “Bee Day”.
 - Please contact Iotron to plan the treatment time that best suits your schedule.

Visible signs of disease:

- If visible signs of infection (e.g. scale) are not removed prior to treatment at Iotron, these residual areas of infection may give the appearance of infection in the future or make it difficult to distinguish new infection.
